

Peter Robin Flatt 1952 – 2020

Attended Wellesley 1963-1964

Born 13th December 1952, Peter attended Wellesley, as a boarder, from 1963-1964. After Wellesley, Peter attended Freyburg College in Palmerston North and then undertook a career in business and finance management.

He continued to work as the Manager of Business and Finance with WIT (Whatever it Takes Trust) until two weeks before his death. The WIT is a community based, peer support service organisation for mental health consumers who live in Hawkes Bay. Peter was highly regarded and respected for his active community involvement and was also a founding member of the Taradale Lions Club.

With wife Reiny, Peter has three grown up children (two sons, Remy and Jevon, and a daughter, Marieke), His older brother John Flatt, who lives in Gisborne, also boarded at Wellesley (1961-1962).

Peter and Reiny enjoyed their travel in recent years, including visits to Reiny's family in Holland.

Sadly, Peter passed away peacefully on 1st July 2020 at the Cranford Hospice in the Hawkes Bay, aged 67 years.
