

## Stephen Phillip Moss 1959 – 2021

Attended Wellesley 1968 – 1971



Born 29<sup>th</sup> of March 1959, Stephen (known as Steve) attended Wellesley for Years 5-8, from 1968 - 1971.

Steve was one of four generations in his family to attend Wellesley/Croydon. His grandfather Harry attended Croydon School from approximately 1910, his father John attended Wellesley (then in the City) from 1933-1939. Steve's brothers Robert, Brian and David Moss all attended, between 1967 – 1974, and his nephew Jared Moss attended 1995 – 1997. What a legacy of Moss family members to pass through our doors.
